The band would rather use that money saved on their lavishly produced video clips, e.g. "Gone Forever" or the anthem "Slapshot" written especially for the Bundesliga EHC Freiburg hockey team. In 2017, MAXXWELL sounds wider, harder, more catchy and also playful, but still true to MAXXWELL: down to earth, straightforward, and straight to the face. In 2018, the fourth album will be released, on which the five Swiss are working hard. And in between, the band continues to play their asses off.
